Address: 525 Catoctin circle, NW, Leesburg
Acreage: 9 AC. Acquired: 1987
Description, character, and use: Foxridge Park is a community park located in the SW quadrant. It is bordered by Catoctin Circle, a Loudoun County Public Schools vocational high school, residential development, and the W&OD Regional Park. The site is divided into two separate parcels separated by residential development. The northernmost parcel has flat topography, primarily open grass areas, and contains active recreation features. The southernmost parcel is flat, with some park tree areas, and contains no active recreation features.
