3. Are we allowed to dispose of MSW, Yard waste, and Recycle materials at any licensed facility of our choosing in or out of Loudoun County?

4. Can we get a list of the sites the current hauler is using for:

MSW	Loudoun County Landfill and other approved disposal facilities
Recycling	Current hauler uses their own facility in Sterling, Virginia
Yard Waste	Loudoun Composting

5. Will the town allow for changes in the service schedule and specific days to be more efficient, when agreed to by the town?

Yes, but will require a change to the Town Code, which requires Town Council approval.

6. Is the 2013 rates adjustment of +1.27% listed on the spreadsheet, currently being charges the town, or is this a proposed adjustment submitted by the current hauler not yet in place?

2012 rates were increased by 1.27% to set the current 2013 rates.

2009 = 0, first contract year

9. I could not find in Chapter 28 or the RFP anything about the age of the trucks, only that they meet chapter 28 guidelines and are clean and in good working order. Is there any regulation on the age of the trucks? Is a 3, 4 or 5 year truck ok?

The Town of Leesburg has no specific age limitation for trucks.

10. I searched the town website and was unable to find Town of Leesburg Code Chapter 28 that is referenced several times in the RFP for Trash and Recycling Could you please help me get my hands on that?

11. The per unit price spread sheet you sent the second column says “number of units” does this refer to number of actual real estate units(5 condos, 5 buildings) or is this the number of Refuse Containers? The reason I ask is in column 3 line # 7 “collection of six (6) CY containers(plural) three (3) times per week” or is this actual quantity of “6” (6 CY containers). Line 9 says I unit and “container” Where line 15 states “container” not containers and it is one unit.

Maybe I am missing and did not read this enough or I am reading too much into it. Please let me know.
