All other requirements of the original specifications shall remain in effect in their respective order. The bidders shall acknowledge receipt of this Addendum in the appropriate location in the Bid Forms.

**Specifications:**

Project Special Provisions PSP-4 Engineer's Field Office

**Remove** the following items from the equipment list on page PSP-2: Telephone Service; Desktop Computer; Fax Machine; Telephone; and Answering Machine.

**Questions:**

Question 1. Are you going to revise the bid form? We cannot find a line item for the Flag line poles. Should it be included in another item?

**Answer 1. No, the Flag Line Detail on Sheet 16, Note #2 indicates payment is to be included in the line item for Mobilization. Please also review Project Special Provision PSP-3 Temporary Construction Zone Flagging.**

Question 2. Is there a place onsite to waste the excess material?

**Answer 2. No, due to grading limitations imposed by FAA standards, there are no identified waste areas on-site. Excess material shall be anticipated to be hauled off-site. The Town of Leesburg reserves the right to negotiate with the Contractor to retain the excess material should a Town owned property become identified for a waste site.**

Question 3. Where is the pay item for the piping at the sediment basin?

**Answer 3. The outfall structure/piping is included in the cubic yard pay item for Temporary Sediment Basin. Please review method of measurement in Specification P-156.**

Question 4. Will the muck excavation bid item include cleaning out the sediment basin prior to filling?

**Answer 4. Muck, if encountered immediately prior to filling the sediment basin, would be paid for as Unsuitable Excavation (P-152) and would require removal from the site. Any necessary cleaning of the sediment basin during its useful life, would be paid for as Temporary Sediment Basin (P-156).**
