

Recycling Bins

The town provides one free, blue, plastic recycling bin to each household and business receiving curbside trash service. Place commingled recyclables at the curb for pickup *after 4:00PM the day prior to scheduled pickup*. (Items must be by the curb by 6:00AM the day of pickup).

Bins should remain at the house if the resident moves. Additional bins may be purchased for \$6 for the 18-gallon bin or \$10 for the 24-gallon bin at the Town of Leesburg Government Center, 25 W. Market St., between 8:30 and 5:00 daily. Damaged bins are replaced free of charge.

Trash cans used for recycling must have a "Recycling" sticker on the can. (Contact 703-771-2790 or e-mail trash@leesburgva.gov to request a sticker).



Regular trash, bulky items, hazardous waste, yard waste and brush should not be placed in these specially marked receptacles.

UNACCEPTABLE MATERIALS

The items on this page should NOT be included with your recyclables. These items must be disposed of separately, or may be donated where applicable.

If you are not sure if an item can be recycled, it's best to NOT include it. Unacceptable materials can contaminate loads or cause your other recycling to be left behind.

- Plastic bags, wrap, zipper food storage bags
- Styrofoam packing peanuts
- Drinking glasses
- Light bulbs
- Mirrors
- Ceramics, dishes
- Hardcover books
- Paper towels, napkins
- Aluminum foil
- Disposable aluminum baking pans
- Cookware and bakeware
- Household Hazardous Waste materials and containers

Newspapers

- Remove Plastic Bags
- Remove String or Rubber bands
- Secure in Bins
- Include Glossy Inserts



Glass Bottles & Jars

- Food & Beverage Glass
- Rinse Lightly
- No Drinking Glasses
- No Mirrors or Windows
- Ok to Leave Labels on



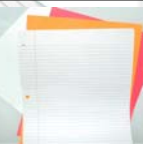
Aluminum/Tin Cans

- Rinse Lightly
- Crush to Conserve Space



Magazines & Catalogs

- Include Phonebooks, Paperback Books
- Remove Plastic Covers/Bags
- Include Paper Inserts
- Secure in Bins



Office Paper

- Include Self-Stick Notes
- Include Colored and Plain Paper
- Remove Staples and Paperclips



Plastic Bottles & Jugs

- Rinse Lightly
- Crush to Conserve Space
- No. 1 through 7 Plastics
- Lids, labels ok
- Styrofoam ok if #1-7



Junk Mail

- Include Junk Mail
- Include Postcards & Advertising Packets
- Remove Plastic Covers
- Include Window Envelopes



Corrugated Cardboard

- Flatten Cardboard
- Remove Packing Material
- Boxes can be combined and packed in other boxes



Paperboard

- Include Cereal & Food Boxes
- Include Cardboard Paper Towel & Toilet Paper Rollers
- Remove Plastic/Wax Inserts
