The Old and Historic District was created in 1963 and followed the incorporated town boundary indicated on Gray's New Map of Leesburg of 1878.

Leesburg Town Boundary in 1758

The act establishing the Town of Leesburg, Virginia in 1758 stated 40 Acres. Former Town Attorney George Martin found it was actually 67.5 Acres.

Leesburg was incorporated in 1813.
