Dear Mr. Voigt:

This letter serves as your official notification of the action taken by the Leesburg administrative panel for signs in regards to BAR Case TLHP-2013-0181; Habitat for Humanity in the Exeter Shopping Center at 700 Fieldstone Dr, Leesburg, VA 20176. Based on the findings that:

• The additional signage and comprehensive sign plan change meets the purpose and intent of comprehensive sign plans in Zoning Section 15.1.1 and are compatible with the existing signage. The administrative panel for signs approved the application subject to the documents submitted as part of the application package date stamped December 17, 2013 including photos and dimensions. This approval came with the condition that all applicable Town and County Zoning and Building Permits must be obtained prior to beginning work.

Lapse of Approval: In accordance with Leesburg Zoning Ordinance Section 3.10.12 this COA shall lapse and become void unless:

- 1. Construction is commenced within twenty-four (24) months from the date the COA was issued.
- 2. Prior to the sunset of the twenty-four month period in 1 above, the applicant has obtained a six-month extension from the Zoning Administrator in accordance with Zoning Ordinance Section 3.10.12.B.

Appeals: In accordance with Leesburg Zoning Ordinance Section 15.13.3.C. All comprehensive sign plans subject to administrative review outside of the (H) Overlay Districts shall, upon evaluation, be approved, approved with conditions, or denied by the administrative panel. An appeal of any administrative decision shall be forwarded to the Town Council for consideration and action

To whom it may concern:

Please see the requested changes below to the existing CSP.

Exeter Shopping Center: (Comprehensive Sign Plan). The shopping center is composed of 23 independent stores, but may be less if some stores take two or more units. The typical tenant channel letter will not exceed 24" in height and one square foot per linear foot of store frontage. All letters will be red internally illuminated with dark bronze aluminum channel letter returns.

We propose to construct typical channel letter signs similar to "Nails Hair" already installed on one of the units. This would be a standard for all signs except the two anchor stores. Would you permit script text, serif/sans serif text and logos?

The two anchor tenants, one at each end of the building, will have different signs.

7-11 at one end of the building will have two box signs, with their corporate logo and colors: red, green and orange on white opaque plate. Box sides and tri will be dark bronze aluminum. Box signs will be 9'x3' each or 27 SF, for a total of 54SF. Signs will be internally illuminated.

Zips Dry Cleaners, will be the second anchor store will be at the other end of the building, with two signs 7'-2"x2'-7" for total of 36 SF, for both signs. Zips Dry Cleaners will have backlit 4 red circles with black letters and box sign under with white opaque letters on dark bronze aluminum plate.

The two, anchor tenants, have 10 years lease with option to extend the lease. If case if any of the tenants closing in the future we will come to the board to revise comprehensive plan taking in the consideration new tenants in these spaces.

Habitat for Humanity, the second anchor store, will be at the other end of the building, with two signs 2'-8" x 18'-0" for total of 90 SF, for both signs. Each Habitat for Humanity sign will consist of an internally illuminated logo box with the Habitat & ReStore logos and individually illuminated channel letters in the Habitat logo colors of blue and green. The returns on the channel letters and sign boxes will be dark bronze as per the other signs in the plan.

In the event of one or both of the anchor tenants leaving the center in the future, the replacement anchor tenant will be allowed similar signs in size, quantity and location not to exceed 2 total signs for each anchor tenant and a total combined size of 100SF for both.

These are difficult times for the shopping centers and for retail business in general, therefore we ask you for understanding and flexibility in order to allow new business to open there store in our center.

Monument Sign: Will be made of Aluminum grey box with opaque white panels with red letters internally illuminated. Box will be held by dark bronze "U" shape frame and will be installed on brick pedestal 18" high. Brick will be same as building brick. Sign size will be 8"x5" or 40 SF not counting brick base.






