Description, character, and use:	Veterans Park at Balls Bluff is a town-wide park located in the NE quadrant. It is bordered by undeveloped lands, light residential development, Balls Bluff Regional Park, and the Potomac River. The site is characterized by rolling topography with a small level area adjacent to the 700' long Potomac River shoreline. The site is about 70% wooded with mature oak/hickory forest, and 30% open field. Remnants of previous agricultural use remain. The site carries a perpetual access easement that allows the owners of Harrison Island, in the Potomac River, to access their property.
