

Eric Brown Skate Plaza Rules

The Skate Plaza is open from dawn to 10:00pm, weather permitting.

No trespassing or loitering when park is closed.

Use of the Skate Plaza is at your own risk. The Town of Leesburg does not assume responsibility for injuries.

Helmets and closed-toed shoes are required.

Youth from 5 to 10 years old must be under the direct supervision of an adult. Youth under the age of 5 are not permitted in the Skate Plaza.

Only skateboards, in-line skates, scooters, and bicycles **without pegs** are allowed in the Skate Plaza. Motorized vehicles prohibited.

Alcoholic beverages, drugs, tobacco products, profanity, offensive conduct, violence, or other disturbances of the peace are not permitted. Amplified sound is not permitted without prior written approval.

Weather conditions such as rain, snow or ice can affect ramps and surface conditions resulting in unsafe conditions. Please vacate area if unsafe conditions exist.

Additional obstacles, modifications or other materials (ramps/jumps/trashcans) may not be used.

Graffiti, stickers, wax, chalk and other forms of vandalism are prohibited and may result in closure of the park.

Eating and drinking is not permitted in the Skate Plaza. Please use the picnic table area. No glass containers.

Animals are not permitted in the Skate Plaza. Dogs must be on leash within the park.

All organized events must have written approval from the Leesburg Department of Parks and Recreation.

The Town reserves the right to close the Skate Plaza or Catocin Park.

The Town of Leesburg Department of Parks and Recreation and the Leesburg Police Department patrol this area. **Call 911 for emergencies or 703-771-4500 for the assistance of law enforcement personnel.** Any violation of State Law, Town ordinances, or Park rules will be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law; and may result in being banned from future use of the Skate Plaza.
