#### Parks & Recreation

The Town of Leesburg's Parks and Recreation Department oversees 18 parks encompassing over 370 acres. The largest park is Ida Lee Park, located on North King Street, and features



a 71,000 sq. ft. recreation center with two indoor pools, spa, fitness center, aerobics room, racquetball courts, child care, and a full range of fitness classes and sports programs. Quarterly program catalogs are published digitally at

Located within Ida Lee Park is the AV Symington Aquatic Center, the Ida Lee Tennis Center with four indoor and seven outdoor courts, two playgrounds, and an extensive network of walking trails.

Leesburg's 17 other parks, located throughout Town, feature a number of accessible playgrounds, picnic shelters, basketball courts, ballfields, walking trails, and open space.

The **Leesburg Dog Park**, with large and small dog off-leash areas, is located at Olde Izaak Walton Park. The **Eric Brown Skate Plaza**, a state-of-the-art

concrete skate park, is located in Catoctin Park.


#### **Libraries**

#### Trash & Recycling Collection

Residents in single family homes, townhomes, and some condominiums receive curbside collection of trash, recycling, yard waste, and bulk items. There is no additional charge for these services; residents receive collection automatically.



Trash and recycling are collected on the same day on the following schedule:

- NW—Monday
- NE, Inside the Bypass—Tuesday
- NE, Outside the Bypass—Wednesday
- SW, plus Meadowbrook—Thursday
- SE, except Meadowbrook Friday

# Yard Waste

Please be sure stickers face the street and are visible to collection crews.


#### **Water & Sanitary Sewer Service**

There is a \$30 initial service charge, along with a \$150 security deposit for residential accounts. A minimum of 24 hours notice is required to start new service. To start service on Monday, submit

#### **Vehicle Registration**

State of Virginia: New Virginia residents must title and register their vehicles with the Virginia Department of Motor Vehicles within 30 days of moving. The Leesburg DMV is located at 400



Fort Evans Road, NE. More information at www.dmv. virginia.gov.

Loudoun County: Leesburg residents must register their vehicles with Loudoun County and pay personal property taxes to both the Town and Loudoun County. Loudoun County bills and collects both Town and County personal property taxes. More information at www.loudoun.gov/cor.

**Town of Leesburg:** Vehicles registered to a Leesburg address are subject to an annual \$25 vehicle license fee. This annual license fee will be included in your combined Town/County personal property tax bill. Once you have registered your vehicles with Loudoun County, you do not need to register with the Town.

## **Dog Licenses**



State law requires all dogs 4 months and older to be licensed. Loudoun County Department of Animal Services issues licenses for dogs in the Town. Licenses are \$10 per year and are issued concurrently with the rabies vaccine effective period.
