Call to Order: The Meeting was called to order by Vice Chairman Silvey at 6:00 p.m.

Approval of Minutes: Regular meeting minutes of December 14, 2022 were approved (3-0-5).

Old Business:

• Airport Capital Improvement Program: The Airport Director provided a slide presentation of ongoing and planned capital projects. The presentation included discussion on the North End Development project, the A-D hangar repaving, the taxiway relocation project, and others. Mr. Forsythe asked about the soil conditions at the proposed South End site development project, which include fill that must be removed to create a buildable lot. Ms. Arrington asked about project to acquire the Runway Protection Zone property and what protections are currently in place. The airport director answered that zoning ordinances, federal laws, and proffers prevent the development of obstructions or other uses that would restrict the use of the airport.


