

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Town of Leesburg is developing an Interchange Access Report (IAR) for a new grade separated interchange (overpass) at the current signalized intersection between the Route 15 Bypass and Battlefield Parkway. Route 15 Bypass is part of the National Highway System that serves as a major commuter route. Currently, the Route 15 Bypass acts as a barrier which discourages pedestrians and bicycles from traveling between the residential and recreational areas east and west of Route 15 Bypass.

The purpose of this project is to reduce congestion and vehicle delays at the Route 15 Bypass and Battlefield Parkway intersection by replacing the current at-grade intersection with an interchange (overpass) as well as provide safe access across Route 15 Bypass for pedestrians and bicyclists between residential areas, parks, schools, public facilities, and commercial areas.




Route 15 Bypass and Battlefield Parkway - Town of Leesburg, VA


SPRING 2022 SURVEY RESULTS

The Town held a virtual neighborhood information meeting on April 28, 2022 to present alternatives for the Battlefield Parkway / Route 15 Bypass Interchange.


More than 220 people attended the meeting. From April 28 through May 16, 2022, a total 450 people provided input on the alternatives presented through an online survey.


