Thomas Balch Library Advisory Commission 12 April 2023 Library Director's Report

Activities:

Exhibits: Town press releases and postings to social media are issued for events

- April 2023: Student Artwork from Simpson Middle School

 Grants:
- Grant of \$4,900 awarded by Loudoun Library Foundation to process papers of the late State Senator Charles Waddell was received and appropriated for TBL use by Town Council on March 28.

Lectures and Author Talks, Classes, Tours & Other Activities:

- Events are being scheduled for Fall 2023 and Spring 2024.
- Arrangements are being made for the Spring 2024 Genealogy Seminar: Judy G. Russell, a legal genealogist, will be presenting on the law and ethics in DNA genealogy and constructing your genealogy from DNA evidence when courthouse records burn. It will be an afternoon seminar (1-4PM, Wednesday 20 March 2024.)
- Registration for all TBL events is required; to facilitate registration a Season Ticket option is available on our event registration page.
- 22 March 2023, TBL hosted the Ulster Historical Foundation all-day genealogical seminar with 73 in attendance. (Attendance capped at 65).
- 25 March 2023, Civil War Walking Tour: capped at 125 registrants; despite chilly rainy weather 82 hearty souls participated.
- 2 April 2023, Ben Griffin Regan's War Stories 33 registrations; 23 attended. **Publications/Products:** Nothing to report.

Building and Grounds:

- Handrail for rebuilt ADA ramp has been constructed; painted and installed.
- Meeting Room HVAC unit has been replaced.

Disaster and Emergency Preparedness:

Nothing new to report.

Outreach: Outreach for March included Laura and Anna assisting with livestreaming the Digital History Workshop with Stephanie Seal Walters, Laura co-hosting the Sycolin Pottery cataloging event with Kelly Arford-Horne, and Laura, Anna, Echo, Helen, and Alexandra assisting with the Ulster Genealogical Foundation Seminar. Additional outreach included Laura attending in person the VA Forum at Shepherd University and Alexandra attending the VA Forum Board meeting virtually. Laura presented a lightening talk at the MARAC VA Caucus spring meeting at ODU University, attended the student dedication at Elaine E. Thompson Elementary School, attended virtually a MARAC Steering Committee Strategic planning meeting and a planning meeting for a MARAC Spring Conference, and provided three interview/tours to MLIS students for their course work. TBL staff collaborated or provided assistance to Town of Leesburg

staff, the Loudoun Heritage Farm Museum, the Douglass Alumni Association, and Loudoun County Public Schools in March.

Collections: March 2023 Activity:

Accessions: 15 donations were accessioned in March. Among these are a circular letter for R.J. Powell's Leesburg dance academy, c 1850s, and a Leadership Loudoun interview with Carrie E. Nokes recorded December 1999.

Additions to existing collections were also received including Sesame Club Records, 1932-2008 (M 027), and records of Friends of Thomas Balch Library, the Black History Committee, and the Town of Leesburg.

Published materials received included Conrad *Aleshire and his Descendants* by Cathy Schott; *Potomac Marble: History of the Search for the Ideal Stone* by Paul Kreingold and the *Ordnance Survey Memoirs of Ireland*. Vol. 1, 14, 18, 22, 29, 37, 38, 40.

Digital Collections, Computers, and Microfilm: 0

Manuscript and Visual Collections: 0 Manuscript collections were processed; 470 photographs were processed; 0 records were uploaded to the Past Perfect catalog which currently holds 7,270 images.

Printed Collections: A total of 245 items were catalogued or inventoried: 70 items were added to the new TBL Centennial catalog by Maddie Russell; 75 periodicals were inventoried for the catalog by Echo; 101 newspapers were received and inventoried by staff, 0 books/periodicals were sent to LCPL and 0 books/periodicals were returned by Loudoun County Public Library cataloging since the last report to the Commission.

Vertical Files (VF): Additions/updates to the microform index (0) ephemera files (0), vertical files (0) unpublished papers (0); family files (0) and maps (0). Anna Carneal is working on a collection guide for the family files and a Volunteer, Ann Geiger, is assisting in re-foldering the materials.

Catalog Project: Is progressing smoothly. OCLC is finishing conversion of the records. A start has been made to printing labels and fixing catalogue records that did not covert correctly. The catalog is expected to go live for staff to review in April and live for the public in June. We anticipate being able to sunset the TBL-LCPL catalog by the end of summer.

Personnel:

Interns/Student Researchers: none at this time

Staff: Laura attended the Virginia Forum in person; Gressitt attended the VA Forum Board meeting virtually.

News of Former Staff: Robert Goldberg touched bases, and all is going well for him and his family. He is going to stop by soon.

Elizabeth Preston has been at the Ransom Center (Texas) for almost 8 years. She noted that working for an academic library shares many of the frustrations of working for a municipal library, but there is a little more space and a little more money. The Ransom Center is getting ready for a whole-building renovation that will require most of the collection to be stored off-site for several years.

Lisa DeZarn is still down in Lynchburg and has just bought a new home.

Ben Tayloe continues to work at Trinseo (Pennsylvania) doing website work primarily, busy with family and hopes to come down to visit someday.

Volunteers: Work on a variety of projects such as scanning and numbering photographs and prepping collections for processing.

Building Use: Laura has been busy preparing the Donaldson Cabin on Loudoun Street for processing collections later this month. The cabin is not ADA compliant for public access/events/exhibits and Laura and I continue to work with the Preservation Planner, Lauren Murphy, and Kate Trask, Deputy Director Parks, and Rec, regarding ADA compliance and historic properties. Laura anticipates being able to participate in First Fridays later this spring.

Action Items:

- Potters Field interpretive sign and headstone were installed at Union Cemetery the week of March 27th. A dedication ceremony is planned for 6PM Thursday May 4.
- Memorial tree for Martha Schonberger: the tree has been planted and a sign will be installed soon. What are your plans for a dedication?
- Leesburg on TV: The Town, Thomas Balch Library, and Mr. Hershman were featured in the March 27th edition of If You Lived Here on WETA. None of the houses featured were actually in Leesburg.

Thomas Balch Library Endowment Foundation: Gressitt, Secretary/Treasurer reporting

- Next meeting of the Foundation is 18 July 2023 @ 12 at Thomas Balch Library.
- Foundation received a \$2,000 grant/donation via Charles Schwab from a donor.
- 2022 Taxes are being prepared.

Old Business:

- Catalogue Project is progressing on target for a June completion date. Barcodes
 for the book collection have been scanned, staff are making corrections to
 catalog records, and printing call number labels. It is anticipated relabeling books
 will start on April 17 with help from staff and volunteers.
- Leesburg's Potter's Field memorial will be dedicated May 4, 2023 @ 6PM. It will be an invitation only event due to space constraints.
- Memorial tree for Martha Schonberger: Both tree and plaque have been installed. Following discussion, it was agreed an 11AM dedication on a Wednesday works best. Gressitt will communicate with family to find several convenient dates to coordinate with various town officials calendars.

New Business:

- Review of budget No pressing expenditures anticipated.
- Following inquiry, it was determined TBLAC members would not be attending the Flower and Garden Show as a group, thus a Gathering Notice will not be needed.
- Looking forward, everyone needs to keep in mind the History Awards.

 the project is expected to be completed by the end of June—the ceremony for the

 Loudoun History Awards
- Commissioners Comments followed, noting the upcoming dedication ceremonies and the chairman informing the commission that his expected health related absence from the commission has been postponed
