Statement of Needs (Utilities/Administration – Amy Wyks, Director Utilities)

Background:

The Town of Leesburg is located 35 miles west of Washington, D.C., in the Commonwealth of Virginia. It is 12 square miles with an estimated population of 54,215. The Town is a full-service municipal corporation that provides the following services to Town residents and businesses: police, refuse collection and disposal, water and sewer utilities, storm water management, airport, parks and recreation, and maintenance of streets and roadways.

The Town is soliciting proposals to provide staff augmentation services for engineering project management and construction management. Services to be performed by assigned personnel may include the following types of projects: pump station upgrades, water or wastewater treatment upgrades, water and sanitary sewer system construction, replacement, rehabilitation, roadway including curb, gutter, sidewalk and stormwater and plan reviews of various engineering/construction projects.

• Statement of Needs (Scope of Work):

Assigned personnel will operate under the direction of Town of Leesburg staff and shall provide plan review, engineering project management, construction management services for various project categories. Assigned personnel are expected to manage projects in all stages from planning and budgeting to design, bid process (procurement), contract award, construction, and project closeout. Refer to the solicitation document for minimum personnel qualifications/requirements.

The Town anticipates the assignment of the following number personnel upon contract execution: two (2) Engineering Project Managers, and one to two (1-2) Plan Reviewers.

The Town anticipates engineering project managers and construction managers will be full time positions. Construction inspectors and plan reviewers may be full or part time depending on project schedules and/or when construction activities are active. The Town anticipates that the number of assigned personnel will vary during the term of the contract.

The Town will provide assigned personnel work space, computer systems, and support services as necessary to perform services. Assigned personnel will provide services during the Town's regular work days and normal work hours, except when the Town specifically agrees to alternate work days or hours. Assigned personnel who come into contact with confidential Town information will be required to hold confidential such information.
