


#### Project Goals

- Improve the aesthetics of the Downtown
- Improve lighting coverage, wherever possible
- Reduce glare and impacts on night sky
- Replace 105-year-old waterline

#### Project Scope:

- Replace existing streetlights & add conduit for power
- Add new power drop next to Town
   Office on Wirt St (behind new screening)
- Replace water line on Wirt & Loudoun St
   main, laterals and meter crocks
- Improve pedestrian ramps at all intersections within work zone
- Mill and overlay roadway




### Project Challenges

- ▶ Historical area
- Proximity of buildings, steps, coal chutes, hydrants and other items



### Project Challenges, cont.

Substantial underground utilities





### Project Challenges, cont.

- Narrow sidewalks Lights must be 12" behind curb and need 36" minimum clear space
- Low overhead utility lines









## Overall Layout





# Some Steps may be Affected because of new sidewalk levels

 Sidewalk will be lower and may require an additional step

Loudoun Museum – Existing Condition




Loudoun Museum – Proposed Ramp and Step



#### WL Replacement Work

Replace water main & laterals up to and including the meter crocks.



- Work will occur at night
- Brief water outages will be at night with 24-48 hours notice in advance



# What to Expect During Construction

- Contractor will work with residents and businesses to maintain vehicle/ pedestrian access
- Most work will occur at night
- Loudoun/King Intersection will be closed at night for water line tie-in work
- ▶ Lanes will be closed at night w/ flagmen
- Steel plates may be used during the day to cover trenches



# What to Expect During Construction, cont.

- Sidewalks will be closed at night in work area
- Parking spaces may be unavailable at night when construction is nearby
- Steps to buildings may require rebuilding to match lower sidewalk levels
- Staging area located in Liberty Lot

Late Summer 2024	Complete Design & Initiate Land Acquisition
Fall 2024*	Complete Land Acquisition & Bid Project
Fall/Winter 2024*	Award Contract & Order Materials
Winter/Spring 2025*	Start Construction
Fall/Winter 2025*	Finish Construction
