Construction Schedule

Construction Schedule:

Start: August 2024 (sanitary sewer work on Old Waterford Road) Fall 2024 (Morven Park Road improvements)

Finish: Fall 2025 (approximately 1 year)

Regular Work Hours:

07:00 am to 07:00 pm

Weekends and Holidays:

No work on nights, weekends town.





House Keeping Items

Driveway Access:

- Contractor will minimize blockage of driveways.
- Driveways will be accessible at end of each workday, except when concrete has been placed that day.
- Property owner will be notified a minimum of 24 hours in advance if driveway will not be usable. Street parking will be allowed when driveway is not available. Town will work with property owners to minimize inconvenience.

Water Service:

- <u>Very</u> limited water outages may be necessary to replace selected water meters.
- Affected property owner will be notified a minimum of 24 hours in advance.
- Outages will be short duration (hours).

Trash / Recycling / Leaf Collection:

Access for trash/recycling trucks will be maintained. Collection schedules will not be impacted.

Mail:

Access to mailboxes and package delivery will be maintained all the time.

Emergency Services:

• Access for Fire, Rescue, and Police Department will never be interrupted.

School Bus:

Town is coordinating with County Schools for modified bus routes.



Maintenance of Traffic

- Morven Park Road will be closed to through traffic each day during construction, but will be open to local traffic. Street will be open to through traffic when construction is not active (nights, weekends, holidays).
- There may be periods when traffic will be blocked from traveling the entire length of Morven Park Road requiring local traffic to enter from either West Market Street or Old Waterford Road. Notice to residents will be provided for these instances.
- Temporary traffic control signs will be installed, and flaggers will direct traffic.
- No contractor employees will be allowed to park on Morven Park Road or adjacent neighborhood streets at any time.

Summary

- Utility construction will start in August on Old Waterford Road, and roadway construction will begin this fall on Morven Park Road. Work is scheduled to be completed in one year.
- During work days, it will be noisy, dirty and inconvenient to residents. However, you will always have access to your house, mail, utilities, and emergency services.
- Except in cases of emergency, when something different occurs that will impact driveway access or utilities, you will be provided with 24-hour notice.
- Necessary services (police, fire, mail, garbage, etc.) will always have access on Morven Park Road.
- You can visit the Town web site for current information. You may register for updates which will be posted monthly.
- At the end of the project, Morven Park Road will a safer, more convenient street.
