Call to Order: The Meeting was called to order by the Chairman at 6:00 p.m. The Chairman welcomed Dawn Klepser to the commission. The Chairman asked that Mr. Wertz and Oaklawn items be moved to first/second in order to accommodate guest presenters.

Approval of Minutes: May 8, 2024 minutes approved 6-0-2

Old Business

• Tax on Hangar Leasehold Interest: Mr. Wertz, Loudoun County Commissioner of Revenue, answered questions on hangar leasehold interest tax. A question was does Loudoun County have authority to impose the tax? Mr. Wertz answered yes as prescribed by Virginia law. A question was asked about assessing tax based on the actual rental rate vs. an average rate. Mr. Wertz agreed that actual rental rate would be used. Tie-down leases do not meet the minimum billable amount.

New Business

• Oaklawn Development: Ms. Novotny and Mr. Shuckra presented information on a development application proposed for remaining parcels of vacant land at Oaklawn. Oaklawn is proposing a data center and residential on two land bays. The data center is proposed on land adjacent to Hope Pkwy and the Greenway. A residential use is proposed on land adjacent to Miller Dr. and Battlefield Pkwy. The residential use would be 184 affordable housing units. The commission questioned the proposed residential use at the approach end of runway 17 and stated that it was

clearly under the flight path. Ms. Novotny responded that residents would receive a disclosure of airport proximity and aircraft overflights and further as it would be a rental property, they could leave if they found noise unacceptable. An avigation easement would be provided to the Town. Mr. Baker said that as a resident of Oaklawn and Commission member, he opposes a data center due to noise. He was concerned that a data center in addition to aircraft noise would affect residents who may increase opposition to the airport.

- <u>Kuhn Jet Center Transition</u>: Mr. Kuhn spoke that a closing with ProJet is anticipated soon, but that he would not have any specific information to share until after closing. He said there would be no interruptions in services and that Kuhn would serve all aircraft types. Mr. Dolan is concerned of losing the Cirrus Certified repair center and asked if Kuhn would fill that role. Mr. Kuhn said no because of Cirrus requirements related to proximity of other Cirrus repair centers.
- West-side Development and Joint Council Meeting recap: The commission discussed the joint council/commission meeting held in May. Mr. Gunnells recommended that a demand analysis be conducted to determine actual market needs from the airport. Mr. Nolan agreed. Mr. Goeller said that he is not sure that 40 acres of land is needed for aviation development. Mr. Roberts noted that the Town cannot sell the land. The Chairman asked that the commissioners come back to the next meeting with ideas on planning development over the next 2, 5, and 10 years.
- Runway 35 Instrument Approach: Mr. Gunnells said he will not expect more information until September.

Reports:

- <u>Airport Director</u> The airport director updated the monthly statistics and projects. The Tower Siting Study is progressing with a VR exercise (VISTA) scheduled in August. The south apron project is underway and aircraft have been reaccommodated on the airport.
- <u>FBO Comments</u> Mr. Kuhn noted that afterhours IFR cancellations were better, but some were still not cancelling, causing calls from Flight Service.
- Airport Business Association Comments Mr. Fisher was not present.
- <u>Air Traffic Manager</u> –Mr. Reilly updated that the tower has been splitting ground control out and running two positions to provide better service.
- Committee Reports:
 - o Operations: none.
 - o Land Use and Development: none.
- Commission Member Comments: None
- Board of Supervisors Representative Report: none.
- <u>Councilmanic Comments</u>: Not present.
- <u>Final Comments and Public Comments</u>: Mr. Boykin said that the west-side wetland areas are watershed from the airport, not wetlands. He also recommended a demand analysis.


