Thomas Balch Library Advisory Commission Minutes 10 July 2024

Meeting convened by Hershman in lower-level meeting room, Thomas Balch Library, at 7:03 PM.

Minutes: Minutes of the regular commission meeting of 12 June 2024 were approved on a motion by Coyer seconded by Woolard.

Library Director: Report attached. In addition, Christiansen requested feedback from Commission members related to presentation of statistical information in the Director's report.

Friends of the Thomas Balch Library, Inc.:

- Friends held a luncheon for retiring Library Director Alexandra Gressitt on 10
 July. A citation and plaque honoring her accomplishments were presented to the
 library.
- Friends updated website with a new URL will go-live in July.
- The Fall fundraiser for Friends will be held on 6 October at the Loudoun Heritage Farm Museum.

Thomas Balch Library Endowment Foundation: Christiansen, Secretary/Treasurer reporting

- Noted that materials requested of the Foundation by the Curator were used at the July 5 First Friday Pop up exhibit at the Cabin.
- Noted that outstanding accounting bills: CY2023 tax and the Balch Trust accounting review had been received.

Old Business:

- Library Director transition and TBLAC's role. Christiansen reported on the transition, noted that staffing, including hiring of a new curator and additional flexible part-time reference staff were underway.
- St James' Cemetery committee Billigmeier noted no new information was available but that the committee was moving forward.
- Commission on Public Arts Baracat-Donovan provided updated information regarding proposed creation of a Performing Arts Council, noting that the Council had discussed the proposal and requested further research and information and would address the topic at a future meeting. Commission members discussed the need for additional support for performing arts in Leesburg and that deferred any additional discussion or action pending the forthcoming Council discussion.

New Business:

- Hershman noted that the Annual report (memo for council) was under way and would be completed by the end of July.
- History Awards Procedures and possible candidates for this year's nomination process were briefly discussed.

Councilmanic remarks: None

Commission Comments:

- Woolard noted that he had recently attended an excellent "Rock the Turnage" event at the Historic Turnage Theater in North Carolina.
- Hershman commented on the nice event held for retiring library Alexandra Gressitt by the Friends of Thomas Balch Library.

On a motion by Coyer seconded by Billigmeier, the meeting adjourned at 8:10 PM.

Thomas Balch Library Advisory Commission (July, 2024)

- Approved the minutes of the 12 June meeting
- Received the library director's report—A number of successful outreach activities in June and early July, involving the Marshall Center, GMU, and the Donaldson Cabin (32 visitors for July exhibit)—staff member Anna Carneal will chair the VA250 events marking the American Revolution—among some new collections received one that involves William T. Sherman—the re-cataloging process is moving toward completion, including newspapers—the 21 June open house reception to honor retiring director Alexandra Gressitt was well attended
- Don Cooper gave the Friends report—their new website should soon be up—the next board meeting is 21 July at Balch—the fall fundraiser is scheduled for 6 October at the Loudoun Farm Museum
- Under Old/Continuing business—the commission and the new director discussed the transition in leadership—the retiring director left very detailed instructions and information that is proving quite helpful—the commission is looking forward to working with the new director—there was no new information on the St. James Cemetery project—the commission discussed the proposal on creation of a performing arts commission, with consensus on the need for attention to the performing arts, but deferring any further action pending Town Council action
- Under New Business—the chairman said that the commission's annual report would soon be fully prepared—discussion on History Awards procedure and possible actions

Outreach:

Exhibits:

A new exhibit for September was installed in the Mercer Room cases on 9/6. The exhibit, "Connecting in the Archives" explores unexpected connections inspired by Thomas Balch Library collections. Included are a section created by Anna Carneal featuring discoveries related to the Poulton Family Correspondence, 1836 - 1864 (SC 0163), Photographs of Alaska in the Armistead Thomson Mason Rust Collection, 1887-1967 (VC 0098) identified by Maddie Russell, and several recently acquired collections processed by summer volunteers and interns

Donaldson Cabin:

- July 5 Pop-up exhibit "Leesburg's Revolutionary War Veterans" :32 visitors
- August 2 Pop-up exhibit "Cats of Leesburg": 81 visitors

Educational Outreach

- On July 24, Anna Carneal attended training about updates to the SOLs held by LCPS at Oatlands
- On August 15 staff attended LCPS Social Sciences Professional Development Day at Dominion High School

Interns/Students:

- Cataloger Maddie Russell provided about 10 hours of instruction to Old Dominion University MLIS student Sara Wolfey. Sara shadowed Maddie as she created catalog records for TBL's Historic newspaper collections.
- Our summer volunteer interns Celia Martini and Kate Morrison completed their time with us. Celia processed the LARGE Loudoun Law Camp Collection, and Kate completed processing of numerous small collections.
- Olivia Mares from Patrick Henry University began work on 8/28 as a Fall Undergraduate Intern

Community Collaboration:

- TBL shared items with the Loudoun Sketch Club for an exhibit celebrating the club's 80th anniversary, the exhibit is currently on view at the County Government Center.
- Anna Carneal attended Loudoun VA 250 Committee meetings in July and August.

Collections:

Accessions

July: 7 Accessions were received August: 10 Accessions were received

Donations of interest:

- Loudoun Volunteer Financial Council Records 1994-2021
- 11 Lithographs by Micheal P. Mesko: depicting historic Leesburg structures.
- Memorial Plaque from the April 4, 2022 dedication of the Enslaved People of George Mason & Dedication Program.
- 145 reels and VHS tapes of Loudoun County High School Football film from the LCHS athletics department. We will digitize a sample of the film with the help of LCPL's makerspace and based on the content, condition, cost and time investment, we will determine next steps.

Cataloging:

- July: Cataloged 46 new books/newspapers in the collection. Added 11 records to OCLC, replaced 27 incorrect records, deleted 6 records (missing items). Added 76 Local Holdings, Updated 204 Local Holdings
- August: Cataloged 34 new items, created 23 records in OCLC, corrected 29 records. Added 48 Local holdings, updated/corrected 145 Local Holdings-information.
- In July and August, 34 historic newspapers in TBL's collection were cataloged for the first time. These included 18th, 19th and 20th century titles.
- In August, Madison Russell and Michelle Champ completed an inventory of the cataloged collections. They carefully scanned and checked the location of more than 21,000 books. The inventory will be used to create a backup list to be used when the catalog is down.

Operations:

Building and Grounds:

On 8/9 opening staff found plaster falling from the ceiling near the cupola onto the floor in the Clark Room from an area that leaked in October 2023. No water fell during the subsequent storms, but roofing contractors identified issues with the seal around the cupola and made repairs. Once it is clear that the repairs were successful, the plaster will be repaired.

Personnel:

- Tammy Linh Tran started work as the Curator of Manuscripts and Archives on Monday 8/12. She is already hard at work learning her way around Thomas Balch Library and the collection.
- Two flexible parttime staff have been hired to fill open hours Eliza Vegas started 9/5, Morgan Dunwoody will begin on 9/19.

Volunteers:

- Several volunteers returned to work after long hiatuses, and several applications were received.
- July: 83.5 hours contributed
- August:86.25 hours contributed

Reference services:

At the August TBL staff meeting a plan for a new approach to collecting stats for library use and reference was developed. Beginning with September stats, reporting will change. Attached you will find the summary of FY 2024 statistics.
