• <u>Ida Lee Playground Design</u> - The Commission was briefed on the steps that will be taken to develop the design for the playground replacement at Ida Lee Park. There will be on-site community input meetings and an online survey to gather community desires for the playground. That information will be used for the playground vendor to develop a new design. The design will then be shared with the Commission for final endorsement.
