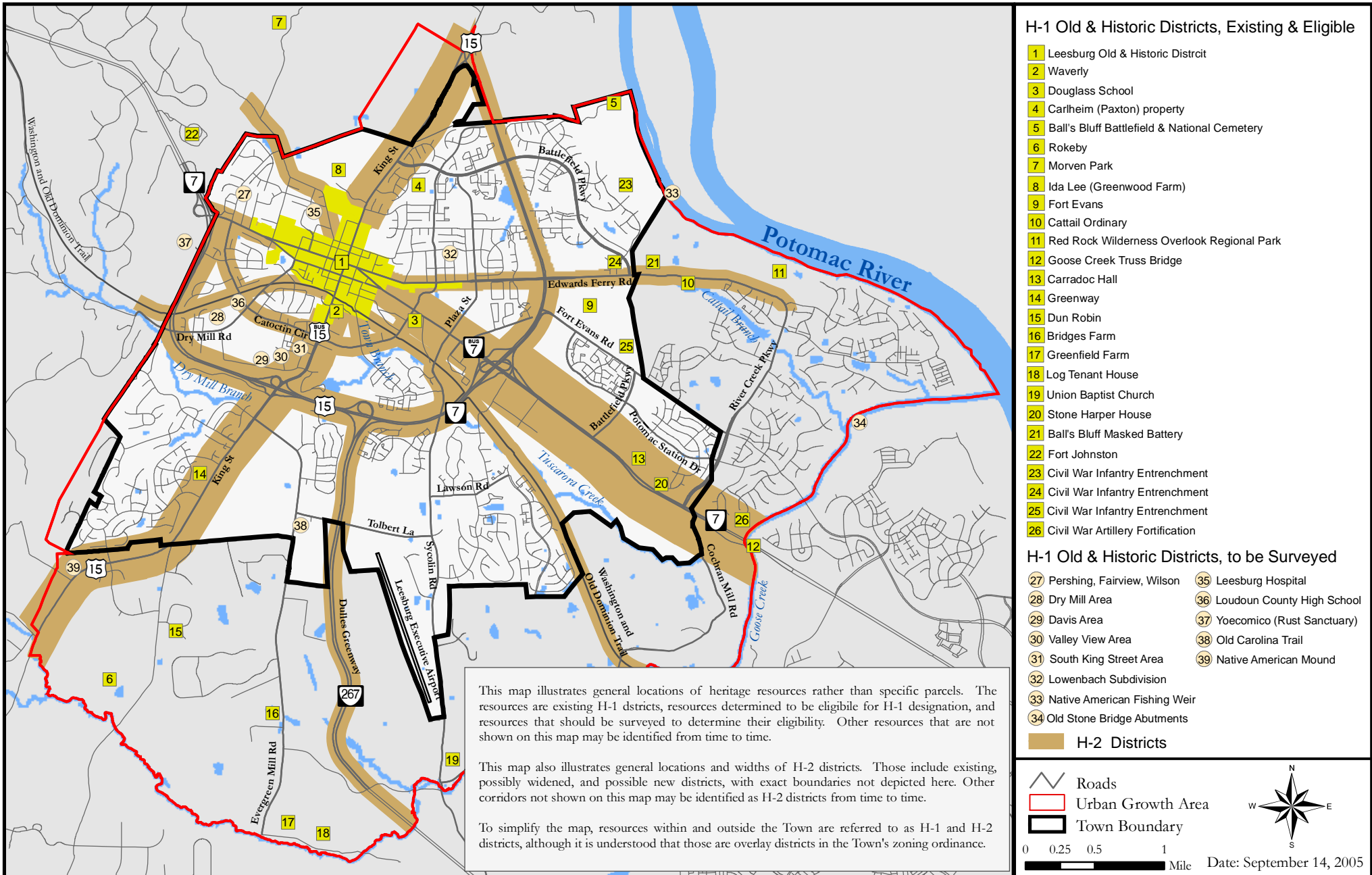

This map illustrates general locations of heritage resources rather than specific parcels. The resources are existing H-1 districts, resources determined to be eligible for H-1 designation, and resources that should be surveyed to determine their eligibility. Other resources that are not shown on this map may be identified from time to time.

This map also illustrates general locations and widths of H-2 districts. Those include existing, possibly widened, and possible new districts, with exact boundaries not depicted here. Other corridors not shown on this map may be identified as H-2 districts from time to time.

To simplify the map, resources within and outside the Town are referred to as H-1 and H-2 districts, although it is understood that those are overlay districts in the Town's zoning ordinance.
