Description, character, and use: Freedom Park is a town-wide park located in the SE quadrant. It is bordered by the Dulles Greenway, Battlefield Parkway, Evergreen Mill Rd., and Tolbert Lane. The topography is flat and the site is open land, with some park trees. The park is Leesburg's primary sports facility and is permanently staffed. Leesburg's memorial to the 9-11 Events is located in the park.
